



Tuesday's Children Junior Board

The Junior Board is a group of young professionals who meet every other month, right now virtually, to discuss fundraising, volunteering, ideas and opportunities that directly benefit Tuesday's Children. Junior Board fundraising events are held throughout the year, in which JB members are asked to get involved in and attend.

Aside from meetings and events, the Junior Board encourages participation from members in whatever capacity they feel most comfortable. For some, that could mean hosting a fundraising activity, and for others, perhaps it's volunteering at one of our programs, becoming a Career Connector and/or becoming a long-term Youth Mentor.



Each Junior Board member commits to a two-year term and to the commitments outlined below:

- 1) Junior Board members are expected to fundraise to help Tuesday's Children achieve its development goals. Each Junior Board member will be expected to donate or obtain at least \$250 in donations annually. These donations may be in a monetary form or may be in-kind donations. (These include ticket purchases to JB events)
- 2) Junior Board Members are required to participate in at least one fundraising or volunteer event per year.
- 3) Junior Board members are expected to attend Junior Board meetings. If a Junior Board member is unable to attend a meeting, he or she shall inform one of the Junior Board co-chairs or the Tuesday's Children staff member for the Junior Board. Every year, Junior Board Members shall affirm their desire to participate and understanding of these commitments via email to the co-Chairs.
